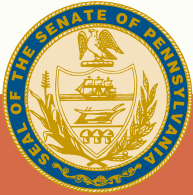
The Pennsylvania Property Tax/Rent Rebate program is open to **state residents 65 or older, widows and widowers 50 or older, or anyone age 18 and over who is 100% disabled.**

New income limits for 2024 are \$46,250 a year for both homeowners and renters.

NOTE: Only half of your Social Security income is included in calculations.

If your income is:	Your maximum rebate is:
\$0 - \$8,270	\$1,000
\$8,271 - \$15,510	\$770
\$15,511 - \$18,610	\$460
\$18,611 - \$46,520	\$380

You MUST bring the following 2024 documents with you to complete the process:

- Driver's License or Photo ID
- Proof of SSI or Disability (if applicable)
- 1099 Social Security/Railroad Retirement
- 1099 Pension Statement(s)
- 1099 Interest Statement(s)
- 1099 Dividend Statement(s)
- W-2
- Other Income received e.g. Unemployment, Lottery Winnings, etc.
- Property Owners - Proof of Taxes Paid either Stamped or Signed by Tax Collector.
- Renters - Rent Certificate Filled Out and Signed by Landlord.
- Document showing Routing Number & Account Number if you wish to have payment received by direct deposit.

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
