The Pennsylvania Property Tax/Rent Rebate program is open to **state** residents 65 or older, widows and widowers 50 or older, or anyone age 18 and over who is 100% disabled.

New income limits for 2024 are \$46,250 a year for both homeowners and renters.

**NOTE: Only half of your Social Security income is included in calculations.**

- Renters Rent Certificate Filled Out and Signed by Landlord.
- Document showing Routing Number & Account Number if you wish to have payment received by direct deposit.
